

# Understanding the Food and Nutrition Service's SNAP Proposal

## Pre-2014 Farm Bill

3 varieties in each of 4 staple food categories = 12 items

Meat, Poultry, or Fish	Breads or Cereals	Vegetables or Fruits	Dairy

## 2014 Farm Bill

7 varieties in each of 4 staple food categories = 28 items

Meat, Poultry, or Fish	Breads or Cereals	Vegetables or Fruits	Dairy

## FNS Proposal

6 units of each of 7 varieties in 4 staple food categories = 168 items

Meat, Poultry, or Fish	Breads or Cereals	Vegetables or Fruits	Dairy

## No Longer Eligible as Staple Foods Under FNS Proposal



## No Longer Count as Two Staple Food Varieties Under FNS Proposal
